Digital Occlusion

Occlusion is one of dentistry's last disciplines that still remains analogue. Unfortunately, evidence based publications have repeatedly demonstrated that relying on bite paper marks to adjust occlusion and restorations is not accurate. Here Dr Sutter will review the literature and complete a live demonstration to share the benefits of digital occlusion. Across all specialties occlusion remains at the foundation, yet is the most poorly understood and widely deviated topic in dentistry.

Dr Sutter completed his DMD from Rutgers School of Dental Medicine in 2005. Afterwards he completed a 1 yr hospital based General Practice Residency at Overlook Hospital in 2006..
